The team at EBTC is excited to announce the fiber project for the town of Aurora and Stanley is complete!! Our techs have been working hard to get all of the homes with in the town of Aurora and Stanley installed with EBTC's fast and reliable 1 gig service.

EBTC's next project will be to replace our 1980s-era fiber on a redundant fiber ring that no longer meets specifications for today's huge Internet demands. EBTC will be burying fiber optic cable from Quasqueton to three miles south of Walker near Schwiebert Drive. Updating our transport route will better serve our current fiber customers and prepare us for the future. In September EBTC sent out capital credit allocations. This is a notification letting you know how much capital credit you earned within the year 2021. This amount will be added to your account of capital credit that you have with us. When the Board feels that it's financially feasible. this amount will be paid out to you in the future. As you may have noticed the capital credit is higher than in previous years. This is due to the accounting for a grant that EBTC received for a fiber project.

EBTC has revised the Internet packages effective October 1st 2022. There is no action needed on your part. The team at EBTC will revise your plan for the month of October and automatically boost your speed where possible. As an example if you are on the Basic plan without a phone, you will now be paying \$84.95 with twice the speed.

Please remember that you no longer need to have a phone line with us to get Internet service.

#### **Increase WI-FI Coverage**

If you are experiencing poor Wi-Fi coverage at your house, we have the solutions for you! EBTC's EVO device is a WiFi extender that works with the Adtran 834-5 router. This is a bundle value of \$250.00, that EBTC is now offering at no cost to you. It's powered by a mobile "app" called Plume. When the router, EVO, and Plume app work together, this combination delivers unmatched WiFi performance and coverage!

We believe that a happy home has access to managing its home network. With the mobile application you will be able to freeze devices, see what devices are connected to your network, see if any of those devices have weak signal, see when a device connects to your network such as when your child arrives at home and much more. Grandma's Apple Crisp

1 cup brown sugar

1 cup rolled oats

1 cup all purpose flour

1/2 cup butter, melted

3 cups apples-peeled, cored and chopped

1/2 cup white suger

2 teaspoons ground cinnamon



Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Lightly grease an 8-inch square pan. In a large bowl, combine brown sugar, oats, flour and butter. Mix until crumbly. Place half of crumb mixture in pan. Spread the apples evenly over crumb mixture. Sprinkle with suger and cinnamon and top with remaining crumb mixture.

Bake 40 to 45 minutes, or until golden brown.
